

Experience the sunset over Deer **Lake.** Rent a single or double kayak and paddle out on to the lake for a spectacular sunset view. You'll forget you're in the city on this peaceful, family-friendly lake. (SW)


DINNER / Walk through Little Vietnam and stop in for an authentic Korean meal. (NE)


